- x Stay in place until law enforcement gives you the all clear.
- x Your hiding place should be out of the shooter's view and provide protection if shots are fired in your direction.

FIGHT as an absolute last resort.

- x Commit to your actions and act as aggressively as possible against the shooter.
- x Recruit others to ambush the shooter with makeshift weapons like chairs, fire extinguishers, scissors, books, etc.
- x Be prepared to cause severe
